### About our Venue in Granada (Spain)

Granada, locally "*Graná*" was considered in 2016 the most [beautiful](#) city of Spain. It is one of the 30 cities of the world you should visit at least [once in a lifetime](#). Granada is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains, at the confluence of four rivers, the Darro, the Genil, the Monachil and the Beiro. The Alhambra, a Moorish citadel and palace, is in Granada. The Almohad influence on architecture is also preserved in the Granada neighborhood called the Albaicín with its fine examples of Moorish and Morisco construction.
